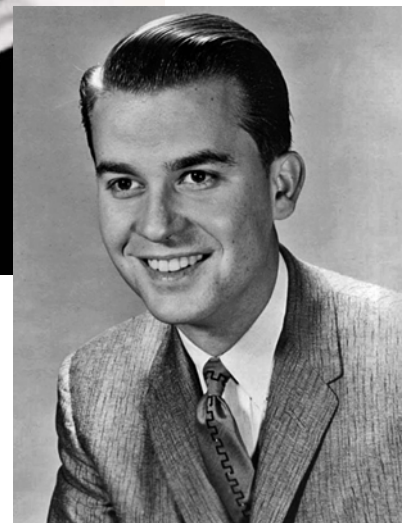


# Famous New Yorkers XVII
