

Newspaper Agreement 2017 Serial Story - "The Path to Freedom"

newspaper, as an active member of NYNPA, agrees to participate in the "When New York Was New" project under the following rules and regulations:



1. The series will be run, one chapter per week until all 8 chapters have been published between January 1 and June 30, 2017.
2. Each and every chapter must be published (in-print or online) with the following credit line: Written by Mike Peterson, Illustrations by Christopher Baldwin. Text copyright 2017, Mike Peterson. Illustrations copyright 2017, Christopher Baldwin. Your newspaper is also encouraged to promote use of the MP3 audio podcasts of each chapter.
3. Each and every chapter must be published with corresponding art work, and sponsor recognition. (The logo for New York State United Teachers and New York Newspapers Foundation to be included on the disk) If recognition is text only it must be written using the following: *Funded by the New York State United Teachers and New York Newspapers Foundation.*
4. The series is available for print or electronic publishing.
5. The newspaper will be responsible to communicate with teachers and readers about the availability of the teachers' guide, MP3 podcasts and Author's Blog. You are welcome to print and distribute the guide. It will be hosted on the NYNPA site.
6. Two tearsheets for at least 4 chapters (**preferably all chapters**) or digital screen shots of this story must be submitted to NYNPA – NIE, 252 Hudson Ave, Albany, NY 12210-1802 or emailed at mmiller@nynpa.com no later than Friday, July 7.
7. Your newspaper is strongly urged to participate in the student contest component of this project. The link will be hosted on the NYNPA site. And each newspaper is encouraged to post the link on your own local website.
8. Should your local students participate in the student contest, the NYNPA will give you access to evaluate their work. You may select your own local winners if you wish. All entries will be included for selection of up to 6 regional winners. Deadline for student input is Friday, May 5, 2017. The NYNPA will provide judging guides (rubrics) for evaluation purposes.
9. Should the newspaper fail to meet these rules and regulations, the NYNPA and/or author reserves the right to charge the newspaper the approximate price a vendor would charge the newspaper for running this series individually. Costs range from \$100 to \$500.
