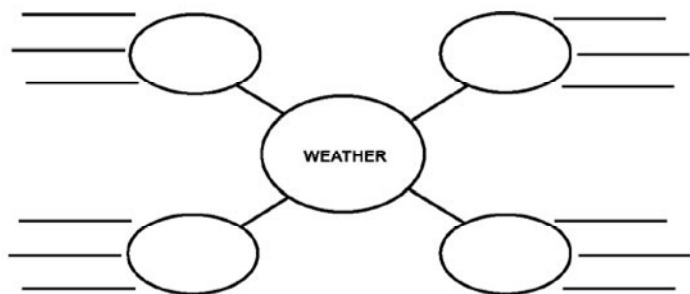


Make a SPLASH READ!
